The first Steelton High Wrestling team: 1936

Wrestling was inaugurated at Steelton High in 1936 under the tutelage of Coaches J. Nelson Hoffman and Charles Hoy.

After a few weeks of practice the Steamrollers entered a quadrangular, District 3 Championship meet at the Harrisburg

Y.M.C.A. on February 29th against 75 wrestlers from West York, Manheim, Hershey and Steelton (finishing in that order.)

In that meet, John Hoover (105lbs) and Dujmic (125lbs) drew 1st round byes, while Dusan Cuckovic won his 1st round bout

by pinning Eshelman of Manheim in 32 seconds. Cuckovic lost his 2nd round bout but won the consolation match by pinning

A.B. Smith of Manheim in 4 minutes, 35 seconds. The season came to an abrupt end, due to the March 17th Flood of 1936

and Typhoid Fever inoculations.

The Steelton High Wrestling program resumed the following year (1937) under the tutelage of Robert “Bo” Capello with the following schedule:

January 29 vs Manheim. Score: Manheim 25 Steelton 11.

February 5 vs Hershey. Score Hershey 36 Steelton 3.

February 12 vs Manheim. Score Steelton 20 Manheim 18.

February 17 vs Hershey. Score Hershey 36 Steelton 3.

February 23 vs West York. Score West York 26 Steelton 3.

March 1 vs West York. Score West York 31 Steelton 6.
