Sc STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME PLAYED AT THE STATE FARM SHOW MARCH 20, 1965. MIDLAND WAS COACHED BY STEELTON NATIVE HANK KUZMA-CHILDHOOD FRIEND OF COACH BENKOVIC. MIDLAND WAS 28-0, AVERAGING 92.7 POINTS PER GAME. THE CRUCIPLE STEEL COMPANY CHARTERED A PRIVATE PLANE FOR THE MIDLAND TEAM.

DENNIS STEWART PLAYED HIS COLLEGE BASKETBALL AT MICHIGAN AND WAS LATER DRAFTED BY THE PHOENIX SUNS, BUT OPTED TO PLAY FOR THE L.A. STARS OF THE ABA.

SIM HILL AND NORM VAN LIER BOTH HAD SUCCESSFUL NBA CAREERS.

DENNIS STEWART WAS NAMED 1ST TEAM ALL-STATE ALONG WITH MIDLAND'S SIM HILL, CATHOLIC. PAT YATES OF LEBANON, STAN WLODARCZYK OF MAHANoy AREA AND LARRY CANNON OF PHILADELPHIA LINCOLN. 2ND TEAM WAS MIDLAND'S NORM VAN LIER, WILLARD KINS OF ALLENTOWN DIERUFF, BILL JANKAN OF READING, DICK JOHNSON OF ALTOONA AND HANK SOUTH OF SOUTH HILLS

STEWART AND VAN LIER PLAYED SUMMER LEAGUE BASKETBALL AT HARRISBURG RESEVOIR PARK.
