ALL-TIME MOST DECORATED ROLLER

Joe Zimmerman – Class of 2001 – 9 gold medals.
Football: District 3 Champions 1997, 1999 & 2000 (3).
Basketball: District 3 Champions 1998, 1999, 2000 & 2001. State Champions 1998 & 2000 (6).
During Joe's career, from 1998 through 2001 Roller basketball teams never lost a District 3 playoff game (16-0), and won a District 3, large school (AAA & AAAA) record 4 straight titles. The Rollers record over that period was 98-28 (77%), including a school record 62 point win over Manheim Central (91-29). During a 22 point effort Joe scored his 1,000th career point in a 2nd round district 3 playoff win over West York at the Hersheypark Arena (74-60). Also, from 1997 through 2000 Roller football teams never lost a District 3 Championship game (3-0), and went 6-1 in District 3 playoff games. The Rollers record over that period was 41-9 (82%).
